## FSC Chain of Custody



The FSC Chain of Custody is an information trail about the path taken by products from the forest or, in the case of recycled materials, from the reclamation site to the consumer, including

each stage of processing, transformation, manufacturing, and distribution where progress to the next stage of the supply chain involves a chain of ownership.

The FSC Standard ensures a management system is in place to provide a credible guarantee to customers that products sold with an FSC certificate code are originating from well managed forests, controlled sources, reclaimed materials or a mixture of these.

By achieving the requirements of FSC, companies can demonstrate they are not contributing to global forest destruction. FSC products are managed to ensure sustainability of long term supplies while protecting the environment.

## Improvement Actions



In order to address some of the identified environmental aspects within an organisation SMART improvement objectives can be set to reduce the impact. Examples could include:

Reduction of energy use by centralising printers, reducing the use of solvent-based products, reduction of waste from off-site installation and servicing, improve the segregation of waste, reduce mileage by planning deliveries and sales visits more effectively, or replacing taps with self stopping taps etc. – All of which can help sustain the environment **and** reduce organisational costs.

## Energy Management

### BS EN 16001:2009



BSI has launched a new Standard which is entirely compatible with ISO14001, indeed, 'BS EN 16001:2009 Energy Management' follows an identical structure, thereby making the integration as simple as possible for those organisations that already have an environmental management system.

The Standard specifies requirements for an Energy Management System to identify significant areas of energy consumption and to target energy reductions. BS EN 16001 is suitable for any organisation, regardless of size or industry sector. However, it is particularly relevant to energy intensive industries or to organisations facing greenhouse gas emission legislation.
