Forest Stewardship Council FSC



FSC is an international, non-governmental organisation dedicated to promoting responsible management of the world's forests. The FSC runs a global forest certification system with two key components: Forest Management and Chain of Custody certification. This system allows consumers to identify, purchase and use timber and forest products produced from well-managed forests.

The Forest Stewardship Council's "tick tree" logo is used on product labels to indicate whether products are certified under the FSC system. When you see the FSC logo on a label you can buy timber and other wood products such as paper, with the confidence that you are not contributing to the destruction of the world's forests.

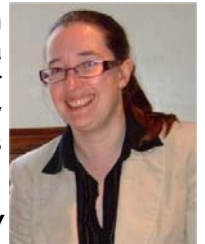

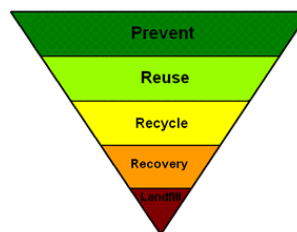

Management Waste Regulations



The Waste Regulations 2011 require businesses to confirm that they have applied the waste management hierarchy when transferring waste, and include a declaration on their waste transfer note or consignment note.

The hierarchy sets out, in order of priority, the waste management options you should consider:



From 1st October 2011, whenever you pass waste on to someone else, you will have to declare on the **waste transfer note** or **consignment note** for hazardous waste, that you have applied the waste management hierarchy.
