

ROLO Recognition for Penarth Management

Penarth, 8th June 2011 – As affiliate members of the British Association of Landscaping Industries (BALI) the team at Penarth Management were thrilled with the news that they were approved to deliver the new version of the Register of Land-Based Operatives (ROLO) Health and Safety awareness course.

ROLO has been revised and updated in order to increase the profile of health and safety and thereby reduce the number of accidents causing harm to operatives within the land-based sector. The changes also take into account the need to align with professional standards such as the competency framework demanded by *National Highways Sector Scheme 18 (NHSS18) for the Natural Environment and Landscape including Ecology*, which was itself revised in May 2011.

By attending a ROLO Health and Safety awareness course and taking a Construction Skills Certification Scheme (CSCS) touch-screen test operatives will be eligible to apply for a new sector specific CSCS card that is due to be formally launched by BALI at the Landscaping Show at Stoneleigh Park on 21/06/11.

On the second day of the show (22/06/11) Penarth Management will be hosting the first official version of the newly updated ROLO course. Run on site at Stoneleigh Park, it will be easy for companies to combine a trip to the exhibition with staff training, thereby reducing costs.

Penarth Management will be offering a special show discount for delegates attending the course during the show. Further special rates may be negotiated for groups. Demand for the new ROLO course is expected to be high and courses will be offered on a first come first served basis.

“We are very proud to have the opportunity to be the first organisation to run the revised and updated ROLO course” said Jodie Read, Managing Director of Penarth Management.

Nikki Feltham, the ROLO scheme administrator at BALI said “we’re really excited to know that the new course is going to run during the
